Guidelines and Regulations (Non-Profit Corporation, Fed ID #94-3166749)

Thank you for your interest in San Carlos Hometown Days.

Booth fees are due with registration. Our 40 booth spaces go fast.

All vendors are being asked to donate 20% of their profits back to the Hometown Days nonprofit organization.

Deadline for registration is April 20, 2009. Fees are nonrefundable.

No reservations are accepted.

All vendors are required to provide proof of liability insurance.

Applications are taken on a first-come first-serve basis, with priority given in this order:

- Small San Carlos based artisans who make their craft by hand.
- A few hand-selected “mom & pop” businesses and a showcase nonprofit.
- Bay area artisans selling hand-made items that are not widely produced.
- Other vendors selling hand-crafted or hand-embellished goods (no jewelry in this category).

****Please Note: replicas of weapons/handguns with flying projectiles are prohibited.****

Please bring your own tent, tables and chairs, as we only provide the space.

All tables and accessories will fit within the 10' x 10' space provided.

Each applicant will be assigned to a numbered booth space.

No camping in the booths. Park closes at 10:00

Be aware that booths are close together. Please don't include loud music, noise or scented items that will infringe upon your neighbor.

You may begin set up at 7:00 a.m. on Saturday morning. **NO EARLY SET UPS ARE ALLOWED.**

You are responsible for your own clean-up. No trash cans are allowed on the lawn.

Please have your booth set up by 10:00 a.m. on Saturday and 10:15 on Sunday.

Closing is at 5:00 p.m. on Saturday and 4:00 p.m. on Sunday.

A roving security guard will be provided by Hometown Days. However, all liability is assumed by vendors. Neither the City of San Carlos, nor Hometown Days are liable for losses or damages sustained by vendors. 11

On Sunday the Rotary will hold their annual 5K/10K Run/Walk. You will not be able to access Chestnut Street before 9:30 am (you may walk across the park from Cedar Street). Set up begins at 9:30 am and end at 10:15 am. All day parking will be available in the Central Middle school lot, across the street from Burton Park, on Arroyo and Cedar Streets. Please keep your permit displayed on the dash of your vehicle.
